An interdisciplinary seminar with Keynesian economists and social scientists in Cambridge discussing their own recent work and also commenting on the recently published book, *Maynard's Revenge: the Collapse of Free Market Macroeconomics*, by the leading US Keynesian economist, Professor Lance Taylor of the New School for Social Research in New York. *Maynard's Revenge* is published by Harvard University Press.

The Cambridge Keynesian scholars who will be participating in this seminar are Murray Milgate who has recently published with John Eatwell *The Fall and Rise of Keynesian Economics* (Oxford University Press); Andrew Gamble, Chair (Human, Social and Political Science) *Between Europe and America: The Future of British Politics* (Palgrave) and Gabriel Palma, a leading authority on income distribution.
